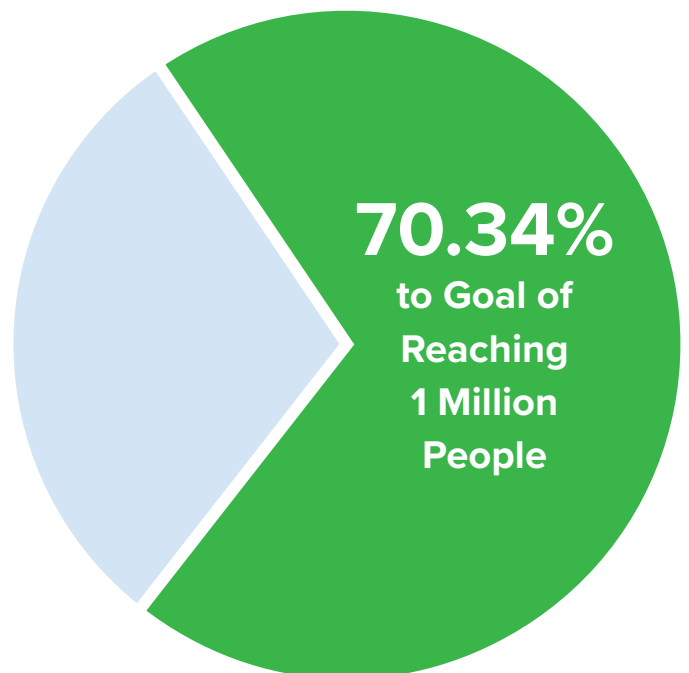

## Afridev MaxLife Centralizer in Malawi

MaxLife Centralizers have been installed on nearly 1,000 pumps—impacting 100,000 people—19 shopkeepers have been stocked and trained, and all area mechanics in Lilongwe District have been trained on proper installation. Community volunteers are tracking key metrics, and an endline survey will be completed in 2026 to analyze performance.

## India Mark 2 MaxLife Upgrade Pilot

We kicked off our MaxLife Program in Zambia, where 16 out of 40 pumps have been outfitted with our India Mark 2 (IM2) upgrades (including the MaxLife Centralizer and a new PVC pipe that eliminates corrosion) in partnership with Living Water International (LWI). During the kickoff, we trained more than 30 LWI staff, pump mechanics, and government officials.

## KupolaCare Wound Therapy

We introduced the KupolaCare Wound Therapy system at two hospitals in Malawi and Kenya. The first patient had suffered from a non-healing ulcer for 22 years due to a thorn injury. Despite seeking treatment at multiple hospitals, his wound persisted. After several weeks of continuous therapy with the KupolaCare device at Kapsowar Mission Hospital, he is now fully healed, and we are thrilled to see him finally on a path to recovery! We plan to treat about 20 more patients over the next year during our clinical evaluation.

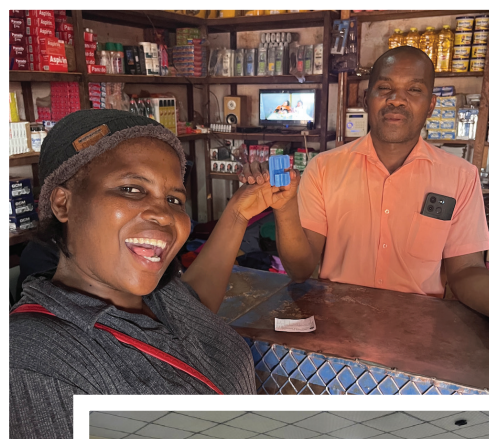
## New & Expanded Malawi Field Office

The Malawi Field Office team has officially moved into their new office, which is strategically located to improve access for staff and partners, can accommodate 5 to 10 additional team members, provides ample conference and training space for up to 50 people, and allows for the addition of up to three storage containers, providing significant room for growth in the years to come.

## What's Next?

**Our goal is to reach 1 million people with life-sustaining technologies by the end of 2026 and 10 million people by 2030.** Through the Beyond Measure campaign—with special emphasis on the MaxLife Centralizer—we anticipate growth, expansion, and global impact like never before.
