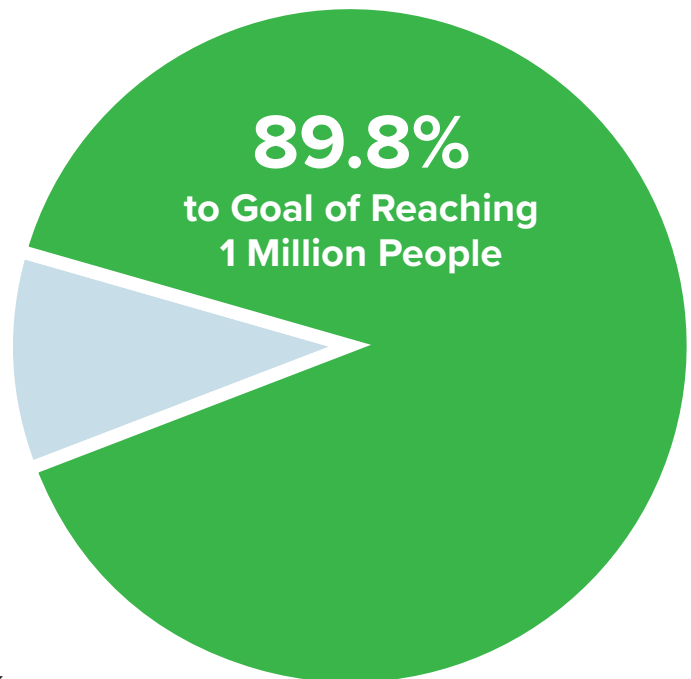

Scaling MaxLife to build bridges to the Gospel

In Q1, we impacted 125,000 people with the MaxLife™ Centralizer and 4,500 with India Mark 2 MaxLife upgrades. Most important, we used our MaxLife Program as a springboard for our expanded Gospel Outreach initiatives, which include launching audio Bible listening groups and providing discipleship and training opportunities in partnership with local churches.

In Kanjuchi, Malawi, for example, 14 women meet twice a week to listen to the audio Bible and discuss God's Word together. One woman testified that listening to the audio Bible has strengthened their spiritual lives and fostered increased unity and forgiveness within their community.

Improving LifeTap through testing and design

This quarter, the team developed a new LifeTap™ fatigue stand, designed to replicate real-world use. The device tests durability through repeated cycles until failure. It will provide critical insight into how LifeTap performs in the field, enabling faster design improvements.

We also began the design process to improve LifeTap, including prototyping new concepts. There have already been some exciting enhancements to the existing design. The process of building and testing these ideas will continue throughout the year.

Strengthening LifePump through new partnerships

The team worked with a new manufacturing partner this quarter in South Africa to create updated LifePump™ components and enable local production. At the same time, new repair methods and specialized tools were tested and implemented to improve how existing systems are maintained. During a March trip to South Africa, the team also visited with multiple gearbox refurbishment vendors. As the gearboxes age, having a vendor in South Africa who can refurbish them would be more economically viable than full replacement—helping ensure this flagship product remains a reliable source of safe water for the most remote communities in Africa.

Expanding access to healing through KupolaCare

The KupolaCare™ team continues to expand access to effective wound care in Malawi and Kenya. In Q1, the team focused on implementing recent updates to dressing material and application technique—training hospital staff and observing real-world use to improve outcomes. A new dressing seal technique proved to be a major success, helping the KupolaCare device maintain consistent negative pressure.

The team also gathered insights into procurement and purchasing for mission hospitals to determine a plan for scaling to more medical facilities across Africa. In addition, feedback from the fall usability study led to device upgrades that improve ergonomics, including new handles that were well received.

What's Next?

Our goal is to reach 1 million people with life-sustaining technologies by the end of 2026 and 10 million people by 2030. Through the Beyond Measure campaign—with special emphasis on the MaxLife Centralizer—we anticipate growth, expansion, and global impact like never before. None of this work would be possible without people and organizations like you—thank you for your partnership in the Gospel!
